



2019 East Texas What-A-Melon Festival

July 11th, 12th, and 13th - On the Center Square, Center, Texas

The 30th Annual What-A-Melon Festival will draw 5,000+ visitors to enjoy carnival rides, games, contests including 'The Biggest Watermelon Contest', food, craft & merchandise booths, live music & entertainment under the Big Tent, The Pink 'N Green Pet Contest and The Annual Miss East Texas What-A-Melon Pageant. This is a fun, family-oriented good ol'time!

LOCATION: Grounds of the historic 1885 Shelby County Courthouse in downtown Center, Texas. Center is located 60 miles from Shreveport, LA –60 miles from Lufkin, TX –180 miles from Texarkana, TX –180 miles from Houston & Dallas, TX.

COMMERCIAL VENDOR INFORMATION

Required Hours of Operation: Thursday, July 11th and Friday, July 12th from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. and Saturday, July 13th noon until 9pm (no events scheduled from noon to 3pm due to heat). Grounds cleared at 11 p.m. each night. Security on site all night after grounds cleared. NO vendors are allowed to stay overnight on grounds.

Set Up: Spaces are priced by a 10'x 10' canopy-covered space. Each space has one 110-volt electric plug. If 220-plugs are required, they can be provided on a first come, first served basis. The number of 220-plugs is limited. Set up begins after 1 p.m. Thursday, July 11th. Portable toilets are on site.

Take Down: Saturday, July 13th, after 9 p.m. No vehicles inside of festival until 10 p.m.

Entry Buttons: You will receive 2 free entry buttons upon arrival per space. Additional buttons may be purchased at an entry booth for \$5.00 each.

NO EXCEPTION RULES:

NO guns, knives, drug paraphernalia, loud or foul smelling noise makers, fireworks to be sold.

NO look-alike weapons to be sold.

NO alcohol use, **NO** alcohol on premises, **NO** foul language.

NO soft drinks or bottled water to be sold.

If any of these are detected you will be asked to remedy the exception and/or asked to leave and will lose your security deposit. The What-A-Melon Festival has a long history of fun and safety— our great vendors are part of this history— let's continue it!

Prices: Craft and Merchandise Booths are \$125 per space. Food vendors are \$250 per space. Each application **must** be accompanied by money orders in the amount of the space(s) fee. Applications accepted on a first paid/first accepted basis, to limit duplication of vendor types.
